## OAK VIEW BASKETBALL LEAGUE GYM USAGE RULES 2019-2020

These rules are established for the safety of all persons in the gym, proper maintenance of the building and the security of the school. Coaches are responsible for making sure all players and visitors know and abide by the rules. Obeying the rules is a firm condition for using the school facility. Individuals and/or teams who refuse to follow these rules will not be allowed to use the school facility.

- 1. The SACC Program (our after school care) has use of the gym until 5:00 P.M. No one is to enter the gym before these times.
- 2. For practices, all players and parents are to enter the gym through the gym doors closest to the parking lot. If the gym door is locked, do not attempt to enter the building through the office or cafeteria. You must wait for your coach to let you in through the gym doors.
- 3. All doors to the gym are to remain locked between the hours of 5 PM to 6 PM. Coaches will be responsible for letting their team members into the gym and making sure the door is shut behind them. The gym door is not to be propped open during this time.
- 4. At all times, while in and on school property, all children (siblings, guests, etc.) must be under direct parent or adult supervision.
- The schools' playgrounds and track are closed to unsupervised children during training leagues and game days and <u>closed to everyone at darkness</u>, <u>which</u> <u>includes all practice times</u>. <u>This rule will be strictly enforced</u>.
- 6. At no time should there be children on the premises without a parent, guardian, supervising coach or supervising adult with them.
- 7. <u>The gym is to be respected for practice and games in the same manner as a school assembly</u>. All children should be supervised and sit on the bleachers. <u>No one is</u> allowed under the bleachers or on the stage at any time.
- 8. Only non-marking soled basketball shoes are allowed on the gym floor. Only the coaches and players are allowed on the basketball court.
- 9. Only the clock operator and scorekeeper may sit on the stage. Everyone must enter and exit through the stage door. No one is permitted to jump up on the stage or sit on the protective mats. All visitors and spectators are to sit in the bleachers. Parents must supervise their children at all times. Additionally, team members must be under an adult's supervision at all times as well.

- 10. The security gate will be in place and no one is allowed beyond it. Coaches must monitor their team's use of the restrooms and water fountains. For safety reasons, team members are not allowed to run to the water fountains or restrooms.
- 11. Equipment is not to be removed from the gym. Use only the equipment that has been authorized for your use.
- 12. Attempted dunks, slams or hanging from the basketball goal rims are strictly prohibited.
- 13. Use of the facility is with the agreement that it is cleaned up after use. This includes the gym, lobby, restrooms and concession stand. Use the trash cans for all food and drink refuse. If the facility is not left clean, the users will be billed for the cost of the cleaning.
- 14. An Oak View staff member will serve as facility supervisor during all games. They are to supervise the building and enforce all rules. Teams and/or individuals not adhering to the rules will be referred to the basketball league's chairperson and if resolution is not attained, they will be referred to the principal.
- 15. Bleachers: If closed, climbing and sitting on top is prohibited. When open, walking on top bleacher is not allowed and playing under the bleachers is prohibited.
- 16. Team members waiting to play or practice should enter the gym area and sit in the bleachers until their game or practice time. These players will not be allowed to dribble on the sides of the court while waiting. Coaches will be responsible for their players.
- 17. Balls used in warm-ups should be immediately replaced on the racks after use and never allow balls to remain on the floor while players are running or in drills.
